SAD DEATH OF A COLLIER AT COLEORTON.

Today information reached Mr. Deane, Coroner for North Leicestershire, at Loughborough, of the death of John Marsden, aged 71, coal miner, at Coleorton. Deceased was working in the Coleorton pit on January 10th, when a fall occurred, and a large stone dropped upon his thigh. He was conveyed home and attended by Dr. Jamie, of Coalville. The cause of death is uncertain, as no bones were broken by the accident in the coal pit and deceased had been out and about since the occurrence. Death took place on Friday night last. — The Coroner, who has given instructions for a post-mortem examination, will hold the inquest in due course.
