A weed control fabric was laid along the winding drum void, covering both the brick pavement at the south end of the void and the clay at the north end.

A wooden marker was fixed across the void to delineate the transition from the brick pavement at the south of the void from the clay at the north. The weed control fabric was covered with pea shingle.

Image bottom left is view from the north end, bottom right is from the south end.







This was the last main job of the excavation that began in 2006. The physical part of the dig has now ended, although there are some minor elements to complete.




Surveyed scale drawing of engine house complex, made from measurements of the site and buildings, in two parts.
