- The Swannington Incline the final inclined section of the Leicester to Swannington Railway, one of the first railways in the world, adjacent to our Snibston No 3 mine site.
- Hough Mill an 18th century windmill under restoration
- The Gorse Field an area of ancient unfarmed heathland with evidence of mining way back to the Middle Ages.
- Califat Spinney the site of a 19th century mine
